

## Practice Solutions: Panic Alarm, Self Installation Guide.

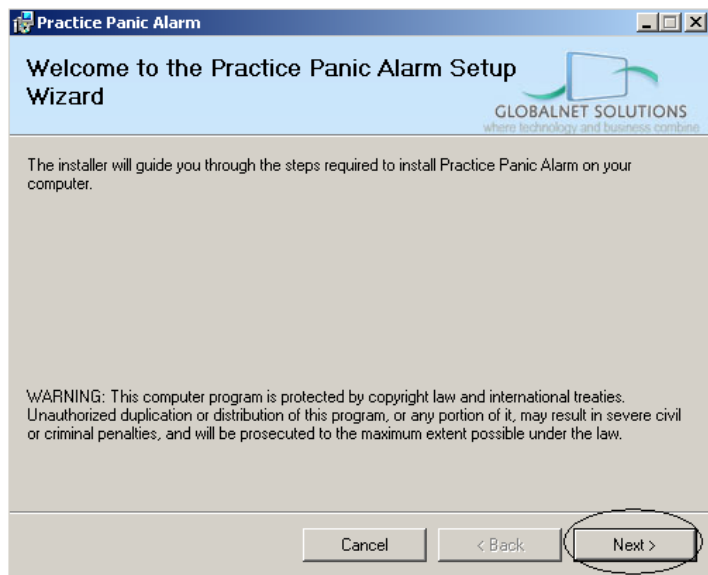
### Installing the Panic Alarm

**Step 1.** Double click the PracticePanicAlarm.msi file available for download on [www.practicesolutions.ie](http://www.practicesolutions.ie).

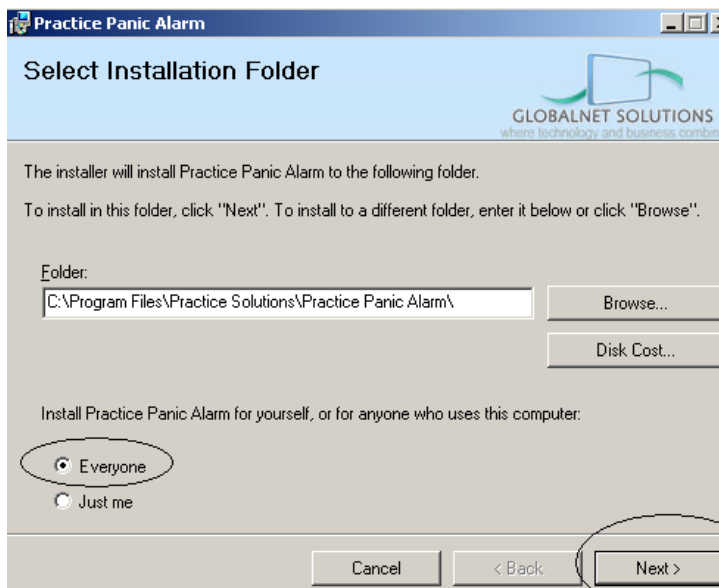
Click Run to “Open File Security warnings” you may see. This is a normal windows security warning feature.




**Step 2.** Click Next to the initial welcome screen to get started.



**Step 3.** Select "Everyone" to install on all user logins and select next



**Step 4.** Enter your unique information i.e. name and location see example below. And select next.



**Step 5.** Click Next to confirm the install.

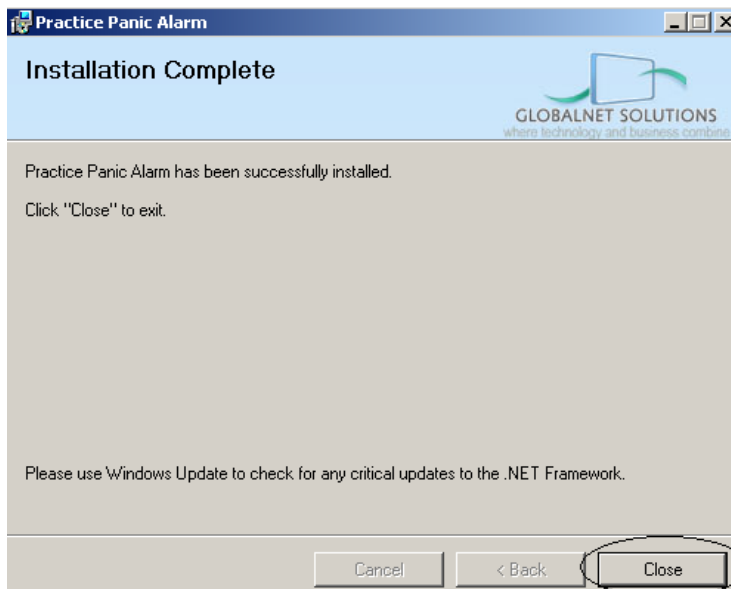

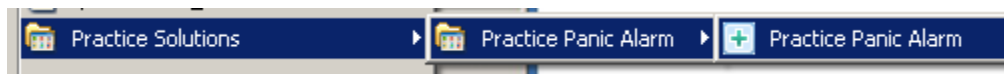

### Locating the Panic Alarm

1. On your taskbar

- a.  The Panic Alarm is the green cross icon on your taskbar
- b. By double clicking this icon, it will bring up you onscreen Panic Alarm button

- c. By right clicking your taskbar icon you can update you identifier information and or license information.

2. On your screen



- a. You can invoke your panic alarm
- b. You can edit your identifier
- c. You can visit the practice solutions web page
- d. You can close the onscreen button and the application will remain on your taskbar
- e. Left click and hold the mouse to move the button around the screen.
